



# 1939—Spring-Frame




A very simple form of springing is employed on the new 98 and 125 c.c. Coventry Eagle lightweights. Any rebound is taken by rubber buffers

Examples of Rear springing Systems Available on Next Year's Models: Drawings that Reveal the Various Methods of Construction




Developed through racing, the Norton plunger-type rear springing is particularly neat


(Below) By an ingenious link system the Ariel spring frame ensures that the rear chain tension is not affected by the movement of the wheel




For 1939 the O.E.C. rear springing has a much increased range of movement

Enclosed plunger-type springing is standard on all Brough Superior machines other than the "SS 80 Special"





No actual springs are employed in the Velocette frame. The movement of the wheel and the damping are controlled by a combined pneumatic and hydraulic system









#### McLaren Vale—Tiddlers ride—Sunday 26th August 2012.

Tony Morrisset and Jim Mottillo really know how to turn on a bight and sunny day for the 2nd McLaren Vale Tiddlers ride. I must thank Michael Scarpantoni for allowing us to use the Oxenberry Farm carpark and premises as the base for the annual tiddlers ride.

The weather bureau was right, that after 3 miserable days of rain, hail, snow and driving winds, Sunday turned out to be a lovely sunny day with a slight chill in the air.

Tony briefed the member on what to expect on the ride and warned that two hills will be a challenge for the tiddlers. The first hill, Willunga hill proved to be a nightmare for Colin Benn and his 1920 Harley Davidson and guest Pete and Deb Fagan and their 1914 Triumph as both failed to make the climb. Pete Fagan joined us later on about the last 5kms of the ride demonstrating that the Triumph's problem was fixed, but Colin still had running problems and remained at the base. It was noted that Bob Gill dusted of his 1937 Royal Enfield for the occasion, & Daryl Rosser miss judged the fuel consumption of his 1924 AJS.

We gathered at the top of Willunga Hill and waited for John Mills to complete the back-up trailer duties before we ventured off thru the hills and dales before a brief stop at Meadows for coffee and food. Along the way we encountered another steep hill, but every one arrived at Meadows.

We left the high country and headed back on a twisting and winding road back into McLaren Flat and eventually arrived at Oxenberry Farm where Jim Mottillo had freshly cooked sausages and onions and soft drinks at the ready.


# **ALL INDIAN RALLY**
