

Lane filtering now legal

Motorcyclists can now legally ride between two lanes of slowmoving traffic – a practice known as lane filtering – however, there are a few restrictions in place. Namely, motorcyclists:

- can only lane filter if it's safe and practical to do so, and in a way that seeks to avoid collisions – for example, making sure there's sufficient room between traffic;
- can't travel at more than 30km/h;
- are not allowed to lane filter at all if they're on their Learner's or P1 permit, or on a moped (unless they have a full motorcycle licence); and
- finally, they can't lane filter through a roundabout, school zone or crossing.

Unlawful lane filtering attracts a fine of \$363, plus a \$60 Victims of Crime Levy and three demerit points, so make sure you're following the rules. These changes came into effect on 15 April.





Sunbeams also made a V-twin machine for the sidecar market. This 1914 version used a 770 cc engine by J.A. Prestwich of London with a three-speed gearbox of Sunbeam's own make, as was the multiple plate clutch. The partisan work force of Paul Street regarded these machines as being only 'half a Sunbeam' because of the proprietary engine. They were finished in the same way as contemporary Sunbeam cycles, with all links, controls and adjustable fittings nickel plated.



A familiar but charming photograph, this shows the 'works' demonstrator DA 1348, a JAP 6 hp twin fitted with a 'Gloria' boat-shaped cane body, in 1913. There is a large leather case on the carrier and the outfit looks well-used, the absence of fresh road dirt on the rider suggesting that she had not been long in the saddle. The sidecar mudguard is box-lined, cycle-fashion, though Sunbeam never lined mudguards, chaincases and handlebars on motor cycles. <u>Changes to the Conditional Registration Scheme for Historic, Left Hand Drive, Street Rod Vehicles</u>. • Now known as <u>Club Registration</u> – a 90 day conditional registration scheme for Historic, Left Hand Drive and Street Rod Vehicles.

 \cdot Vehicles will no longer need to be inspected by clubs prior to approval (MR334) being granted, although individual clubs are free to impose their own inspection requirements.

· Vehicles not previously registered in SA (or previously SA registered vehicles not able to be located on historical records) may still need a departmental identity inspection prior to registration.

• Year of eligibility will be a rolling 30 year from 1 January of each year. For example, all vehicles built in 1987 will be eligible from 1 July 2017 when the changes take effect. Vehicles built in 1988 will become eligible on 1 January 2018.

• The year of eligibility will be calculated from the date of manufacture, not compliance. In instances where a **year may be recorded incorrectly on the registration and licensing database, owners can have the vehicle's** identification plate sighted at Service SA and have the year corrected. Where the vehicle is unregistered it will still need to be presented for a sighting of the identification plate by either Service SA or inspectors at Regency park or Lonsdale inspection stations. An unregistered vehicle permit may be required.

• Vehicles will be permitted to be modified and still be eligible to be registered on Club Registration. Modifications must be in line with the requirements in the Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2014 particularly Regulation 53. Otherwise an exemption must be obtained from Vehicle Standards prior to registration. For further information see this fact sheet or visit www.sa.gov.au. Clubs are not required to confirm if modifications meet with the regulations or if an exemption has been issued, this is the responsibility of the vehicle owner. This includes Street Rod vehicles.

· Left hand drive (LHD) vehicles will be permitted to be modified and still be registered

in SA. All LHD vehicles will still require a LHD exemption prior to registration, this document may need to include specific references to modifications if the vehicle is modified outside of the Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2014 particularly Regulation 53. These same rules apply to general registration and Club Registration.

· Left Hand Drives already issued an exemption certificate and planning to make

modifications (minor or major) will need to contact Vehicle Standards on 1300 882 248 to discuss. They will need a new exemption issued in either instance. Vehicle Standards will commence a program of identifying exemptions issued and re-issuing with different wording permitting minor modifications but this will take some time. Owners can approach Vehicle Standards in the interim.

• All authorised clubs will be permitted to approve any type of vehicle (Historic, LHD or Street Rod) for registration. This will be gazetted on the first Gazette notice after 1 July 2017 which will be 4 July 2017.

· All club authorised people will shortly receive a new certificate of authorisation and accompanying letter clearly explaining the change to their authorisation.

 \cdot New MR334 books will be available from 1 July 2017 with a revised declaration not including physical inspection of vehicles. These should be ordered in the normal fashion through clubs.

• The old MR334 books can still be used after 1 July 2017. Although the declaration states the vehicle has been inspected this is no longer a requirement from 1 July 2017. DPTI would prefer old books are replaced within three months of 1 July 2017.

· DPTI is happy for logbooks to be issued at the same time as MR334 forms and suggests the person issuing the logbook on behalf of the club completes all vehicle identifiers provided on MR334.

 \cdot Log books will still need to be replaced every three years. The log book will be redesigned in the coming months.

 \cdot There is no longer a requirement to stamp registration papers. This applies to first registration and subsequent renewals.

• A new Code of Practice will be published shortly (before 1 July 2017) and made available on www.sa.gov.au on the Historic, Left Hand Drive and Street Rod page. <u>https://www.sa.gov.au/topics/driving-and-transport/vehicles-and-egistration/vehicle-types-and-specifications/historic-left-hand-driveand-street-rod-vehicles</u>.

At this stage there is no plan to widely distribute as a paper document, clubs are free to print a copy of the electronic version themselves if required.






