Bikes will be judged during the Saturday lunch stop at the Mouth of the Murray SA. The bikes will be judged by rally entrants in the following categories:

Non-Period Entries

- I. All Ariels that do not conform to the above categories. (This may include outfits).
- J. All non-Ariels (including outfits).

Period Categories: Categories A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H are period categories and to be eligible for entry in period categories bikes should have all major components correct for the period. Major components are considered to be: frame, forks, mudguards, tanks, speedo, headlight, wheels & brakes, taillight, chain guard, engine (crankcase, barrel(s), head and carburettor). Accessories should be of the period. Bikes that don't conform to these conditions should be entered in the respective non-period categories.

Non-Period Categories: Category I generally does not adhere to the construction as built by the Ariel factory. This category includes hybrids. Category J is any non-Ariel bike.
