Club details

The VVMCCSA Club is an active motorcycle club, formed in 1956 and dedicated to the preservation, restoration and riding of Veteran, Vintage and Post-Vintage motorcycles. We cater for motorcycles in the following categories, regardless of make:

- Veteran – manufactured in 1918 or earlier
- Vintage – manufactured between 1919 and 1930
- Post Vintage – manufactured between 1931 and 1950
- Classic – manufactured between 1951 and 1996 (30 years prior to the current year)

Club Runs

We have numerous club runs monthly and annually. Most runs are supported by a backup trailer and often include a shorter route for older motorcycles. Regularly monthly runs include:

- Northern midweek ride, commencing from the Gully Pub, Tea Tree Gully
- Southern midweek ride, commencing from the Victoria Hotel, O'Halloran Hill
- Old Crocks and Tiddlers ride for older and small capacity bikes, commencing from Federation Park Gumeracha.
- Sunday club ride, commencing from different locations.

The Club is accredited for Historic Registration, which allows members to register their machines for use on public roads for a maximum of 90 days annually, for a reduced fee.

Swap Meet
